Course in Firearms and Weapons Safety 11029NAT

Introduction

These courses are approved by the QPS Weapons Licencing Branch for Firearms Licencing in Queensland.

The courses deliver the knowledge needed to use firearms safely, responsibly, and legally. They constitute a basic introduction to firearms, covering the essential knowledge, skills, and attitudes to firearms legislation, their place and use in the community, and firearms licencing, focusing on safety in storage, transport, and use of firearms in a variety of contexts.

The club regularly runs safety courses suitable for sporting shooters in the two main types of licences; -

the **Firearms Licence**, which covers the use of a variety of rifles and shotguns (**Category A and B firearms**) for target shooting at an approved, range as well as recreational hunting on private land,

and -

the **Concealable Firearms Licence**, which covers the use of pistols (**Category H firearms**) for recreational target shooting at an approved pistol range.

Young people between the ages of 11 and 18 can apply for a **Minors Licence** which allows them to use firearms in much the same way as a full adult licence, but with restrictions on the ownership and purchasing of firearms and ammunition. A Minors licence can be for Cat A/B firearms, Cat H, or both.

We are also able to offer courses covering the use of semi-automatic firearms (**Category C** and **D Firearms**) as well as Holster Proficiency and Safety Officer qualifications if there is sufficient demand. These courses are presented 'as required' and are not routinely scheduled.

What does it Cost?

Junior shooters and SSAA(Qld) Inc members receive a discount. Current prices are;

Format of the Courses

All courses are in two parts; -

A **Common Safety Course** (NAT11029001) Where you must demonstrate your knowledge of weapons legislation, weapons, and community safety. This part is mostly theoretical and you must complete a written test at the end. Every category of Licence must complete this part.


A **Specific Practical Course** (NAT11029001/5) Where you must demonstrate that you know how to use the Particular Category of firearms legally, safely, and responsibly. This is partly in the form of verbal questioning, and partly in demonstrating that you can use the firearms safely.

When and Where are Courses Held?

Courses are generally held Monthly, usually on the fourth Saturday of each month.

NOTE: Pistol licencing is more involved than rifles and shotguns, and you need to jump through some hoops before you do your safety course. Email training@ssaamackay.org.au for more information about this.

What do I bring on the day?

1. Photo ID -eg Drivers licence, Passport, Student Card etc.

- NOTE; - Juniors also need PhotoID

2. SSAA Membership Card - if you have one

3. USI Number - if you don't have one go to https://www.usi.gov.au

4. Confirmation of payment - copy of the online acknowledgement/receipt

5. Enclosed Footwear - no sandals, thongs, **or Crocs etc.**

6. Closed Top - no singlets, halters, or low-cut shirts etc.

7. Eye and Ear protection - if you have your own; we supply plugs/muffs/glasses

- you will not be allowed to shoot without these.
